Thank you for your continued support of our school community. Wishing you a blessed Easter.

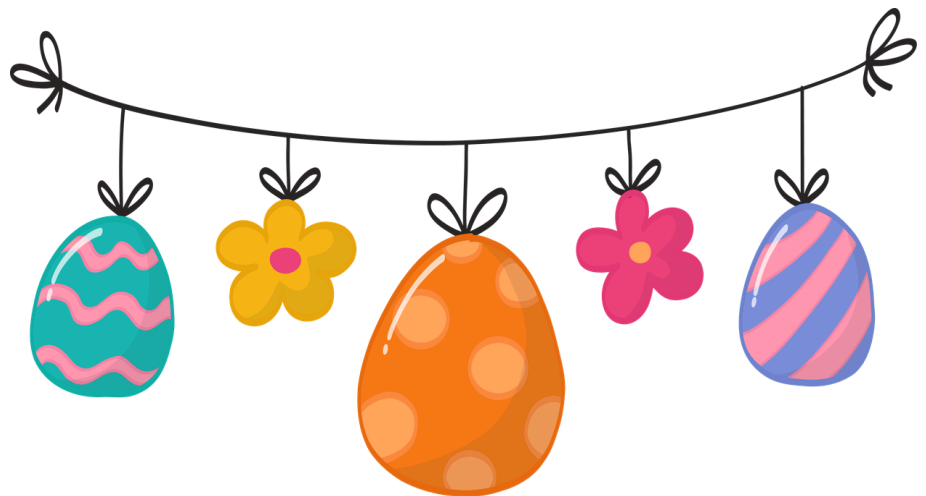

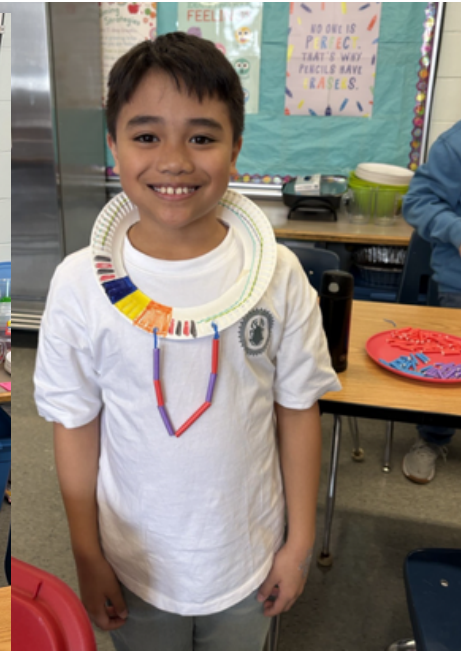
Students took part in a variety of activities, including a lunch dance, skipping challenge, bake sale, pop sale, and creative experiences like African crafts and glitter tattoos.

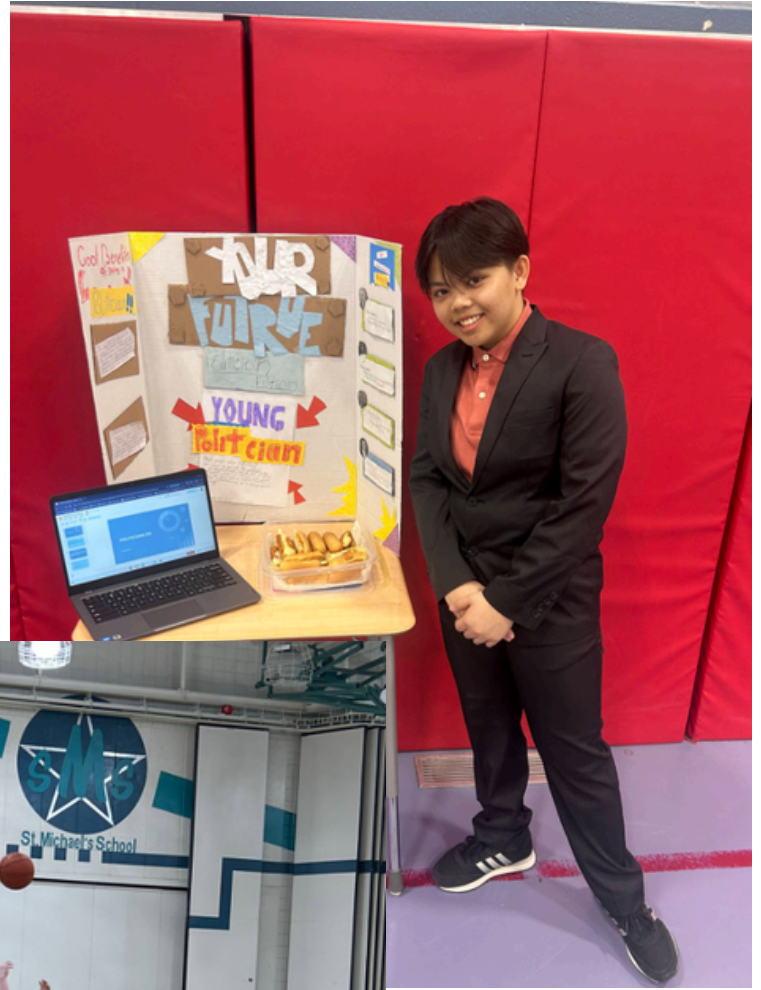
