- Band Camp will be held August 16-21! Register early for \$100 off!



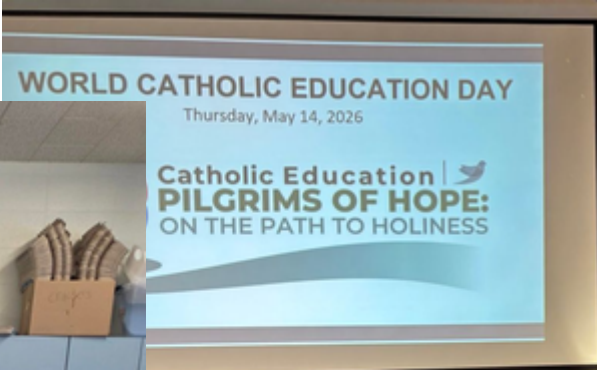


## Thank You!
